Internet and download features are dependent on Internet access to iTunes store being available. CD making features require the installation of iTunes software on Mac or PC, which is available free. * Sections 4 & 6 must be done to complete section 7.

Part 2: Music from our Home:

Complete a questionnaire with our parents, grandparents and in the community.

Hear the music enjoyed by them when they were young.

Let's make a compilation CD of music enjoyed by our parents and grandparents from iTunes and other sources.

Part 3: Copyright

Study the difference between music we have composed ourselves and music we have bought from the internet.

Learn about copyright, intellectual property, pirating, theft and the law.

Part 4: Make our Own Music

Let's compose our own music and lyrics, about life in different countries, or our own topics.

Part 5: Teach Music to the Young

P7 children will compose and teach a simple musical composition to children from the P3 class in your school.

Let's record the results.

Part 6 Make a Cd.

Let's learn to edit and master a CD in iTunes and design and produce a cover.

Part 7: Sell our Music

Let's make a compilation of music we have composed during the course.

Let's plan a marketing campaign to sell our CD to raise money for the school or for charity.

Let's also make podcasts and radio shows.
